Anecdotal

- Based on a constructivist framework
- Never intended for teacher evaluation
- Focused on student assessment results

Theoretical

- Teachers have difficulty grasping how they are rated at each category

- Uses subjective terms such as "most" and "all"

- Multiple documents to shuffle in order to incorporate ELA, math, and SEL evidences in the classroom




